ABOUT LAVA CAP

Founded in 1981, Lava Cap Winery is a third generation family farm, located in the Sierra Foothills, at an elevation of 2,700ft. The winery and Estate Vineyards are located on a unique outcropping of volcanic soil, the inspiration for the wineries name. The result of elevation and distinct soils are wines that erupt with flavor.

VINEYARD NOTES

Grown on the banks of the American River, at an elevation of 1,200ft, this is the lowest elevation location we make wine from. The vineyard lies deep in a river valley, on raw granitic soil where warm days are met with cool nights from air draining down from the Sierra Nevada high above.

WINEMAKER NOTES

This amazingly bright ruby-red wine is wrapped up in vivid red fruit, subtle tannin, and great acidity. Notes of strawberry, blood orange, wild cherry, and iodine. The palate remains fresh with vibrant natural acidity and light tannins. Clove and leather notes linger to a bright finish.
